This trial will run under any COVID protocols in effect on the trial date. By entering the trial, competitors agree to follow all requirements imposed by the Club. At this point, we encourage all handlers to wear a mask during walk-throughs. A decision on food services will be made closer to the trial date, and all competitors will be advised. Full refunds will be made to anyone withdrawing with COVID or with COVID symptoms, or in the event of the cancellation of the trial.

General Information:

Competitors who qualify for an AAC title prior to the trial may move up **providing** the Trial Secretary receives the information **at least 5 days prior to the trial date**.

Obstacles may include: A-frame, Weave Poles, Flexible Tunnels, Tire Jump (break-away), Spread Jump, Double Bar Jumps, Single Bar Jumps, Broad Jump.

A Break-away self-healing tire and electronic timing will be used at this trial

There will be no obstacle familiarization, but two warm-up jumps will be set up for the duration of the trial.

Awards: (RIBBONS & ROSETTES WILL ONLY BE PRESENTED IF REQUESTED)

- Placement ribbons for 1st through 4th place for each division
- Qualifying ribbons for all AAC agility qualifiers
- Titling rosettes to celebrate dogs who achieve an AAC agility title

Facilities: The trial will be held outdoors in a fully fenced grass ring. Washrooms are available as well as parking near the ring. There's plenty of room for tents and crates. The event will still run in the event of rain.

There is a fenced off-leash play area and acres of land to walk your dog on a leash during the trial. We do ask that you poop-n-scoop and keep your dog on a leash or crated when outside of the agility rings.

Directions:

3859 Carling Avenue ~ Nepean, Ontario
From the 417 take the March/Eagleson exit and go north (right if you're travelling west, left if you're travelling east).
Turn right at the lights at Herzberg Road – cross the railway tracks – turn right at the lights at Carling Avenue. Dogz is the first driveway on the left.
From Carling, go west past Moodie Drive – under the train bridge – Dogz is the last driveway on the right before you get to the lights at Herzberg Road.
PARKING will be located by the agility rings – just follow the signs at the end of the driveway.

Notice to Competitors:

All dogs must have an AAC ID number to compete. There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event that a dog and/or handler are dismissed from the trial, regardless of the reason, or in the event of inclement weather. Refunds will be issued for dogs that come into season or are injured, providing a veterinarian's certificate is received by the Trial Secretary within 48 hours of the trial date.
